



## Alternative Meeting Facilities

There are plenty of places just around the corner or down the street in South Beach. And they just may be so much fun, you won't want to go the "conventional" route again.

### 10th Street Oceanfront Auditorium

Built in 1954 by Leonard Glasser, this Miami Modern style building houses the Miami Design Preservation League's offices, Art Deco Weekend Festival offices, Museum and Welcome Center. The 2,000 square-foot Auditorium can accommodate approximately 100 people for lectures or screenings. Big screen, lighting and sound equipment available.

### 21st Street Recreation Center

This community center offers two meeting rooms, stage and dance floor, lighting, dressing rooms and PA system. Indoors: Larger room accommodates 300 reception, 150 seated. Smaller room accommodates 150 reception, 75 seated. Outdoors: Amphitheater, patio areas and open-air chess club available. Small stage theater seats 90.

### ArtCenter/South Florida

This exhibition not-for-profit Artist-in-Residence studio program and exhibition space is located in the heart of South Beach's Lincoln Road Arts District and provides daytime group tours and offers the main gallery for private evening events and meetings. The ArtCenter's main gallery accommodates 150 for a reception. Seated accommodations also available for approximately 60 guests.

### Bass Museum of Art

Podium with sound speaker available, as well as 35mm slide projector and screen, large-screen TV and VCR. Indoors: Accommodates 400 reception, 140 seated. Outdoors: Sculpture garden accommodates 300 reception.

### Colony Theater

This theater is home to local and national organizations in the worlds of theater, dance, music, and other performing arts. The adjacent Colony Cafe is ideal for pre-theater dining, meetings and private receptions. Offers sound and stage facilities, 16mm and 35mm projectors, two dressing rooms, box office, concession area and bar. Indoors: Theater accommodates 465 seated.

### Jackie Gleason Theater

Adjacent to the Convention Center, this theater in the Art Deco motif hosts an ongoing array of Broadway shows and other performances. The theater offers 72 stage lines; lighting, staging and sound equipment; 12 dressing rooms; box office; and loading dock. Indoors: Theater accommodates 2,705 seated. Rehearsal Hall accommodates 200 reception only. VIP Room accommodates 80.
